



HOW TO APPLY APPLICATION PROCESS

Barking & Dagenham Renew, a new charity awarding funds for, and with residents of Barking and Dagenham

Round one of applications open:
November 20th 2017 – February 20th 2018

Grants are available for the following amounts:

- Up to £150
- Up to £500
- Up to £1000

We want to give people the chance to try new things and as they see success, apply for larger grants in future rounds. Applicants are able to apply to each round of funding.

Barking & Dagenham Renew will enable and empower residents with good ideas, to initiate new activities that add something to the borough. Maybe the idea will make things work better, maybe for example it's a temporary event, something that makes your street look better or something to inspire others. We are looking to fund ideas that improve the day to day experience of those living and working in the borough. No ideas are off limits.

We are keen to receive applications for the unusual, the usual, the thoughtful, the small scale – anything really, as long as it will impact and provide benefit to your neighbourhood and those living there.

We are open to any applicant, 16 and over, who has a link to the local area but will strongly prioritise local applicants and will limit non-local applicants to those who can show a close tie to Barking and Dagenham.

The first round of funding is focused on Abbey and Gascoigne Wards so those applications will be given priority. The Charity has received initial funds from B&D Reside Weaver LLP as part of the delivery structure for Gascoigne Estate.

The trustees will continually work to develop and secure new funds for the benefit of residents across the whole borough.

We do not accept applications:

- Which do not benefit the community of Barking and Dagenham
- Which will benefit only the applicant
- For statutory services including schools and hospitals
- For projects that have already taken place and are seeking funding retrospectively

While the application process is intended to be open and simple, Barking and Dagenham Renew does not accept incomplete applications. Applicants who have difficulty in completing the application form, please do contact us for support in doing this.
